NEW RESIDENTS PARKING SCHEME IN YOUR ROAD

Following extensive consultation with residents in your area it has been agreed to introduce a residents parking scheme in your road (or the part of the road that you live in).

When the scheme is in place you will need to display a permit in your vehicle to park in your street (usually in marked bays) during the operational hours of the scheme.

The operational hours will be 0830-1730, Mon-Fri in Kings Road, Longdene Road, Courts Hill Road and Tanners Lane

The operational hours will be 0830-1730, Mon-Sat in Popes Mead, Chestnut Avenue, West Street, Bridge Road, Sandrock and St Christopher's Green

A permit does not guarantee you a parking space and all the spaces in your zone are available to any other permit holder from your zone.

In order to allocate permits as fairly as possible, the following allocation has been agreed:

- If you have off street parking for two or more vehicles then you are **not** entitled to any resident's permits.
- If you have off street parking for one vehicle you may be eligible to buy one resident's permit
- If you have no off street parking you can buy up to **two** resident's permits.

Each household, regardless of the amount of off-street parking, is also entitled to buy up to 120 visitor permits per year. These allow a visitor to park their car in a resident's permit bay for a day.

The cost of a resident's permit would be £50 per year for the first permit and £75 per year for the second permit. Visitor permits cost £2 each. Doctors, nurses and carers can apply for free permits, and can therefore still make household visits, should this apply to your circumstances.
